

Build a Pollinator Water Station

A safe, simple garden activity inspired by Maya

Pollinators need water, too. Let's make a shallow water station with landing stones so tiny visitors can stop for a drink.

What You Need

- ☐ A shallow dish or saucer
- ☐ Clean water
- ☐ Small smooth stones or pebbles
- ☐ A safe outdoor spot

How to Build It

1



Ask a grown-up to help you choose a safe spot in the garden, yard, or porch.

2



Place the shallow dish on the ground or a steady surface.

3



Add small stones so pollinators have places to land.

4



Pour in a little water so the tops of some stones stay above the water.

Safety Tips

- Use only shallow water.
- Change the water often.
- Watch wildlife gently—do not touch.
